- SECTION 1. Section 62.014, Parks and Wildlife Code, is 6

- 1 deputy constable, marshal, deputy marshal, or member of the Texas
- 2 Rangers or the Texas Highway Patrol.
- 3 (o) In addition to any administrative fee collected under
- 4 Subsection (e), the commission may charge a reasonable fee to cover
- 5 the administrative costs of processing the application for a
- 6 license submitted by a person described by Subsection (n).
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
