- 7 Sec. 451.0025. WAIVER OF IMMUNITY; PERMISSION FOR FIRST
- 8 RESPONDER TO SUE. (a) In this section, "first responder" has the
- 9 meaning assigned by Section 421.095, Government Code.
- 10 (b) A first responder who alleges a violation of Section
- 11 451.001 by a state or local governmental entity that employs the
- 12 <u>first responder may sue the governmental entity for the relief</u>
- 13 provided by this chapter. Sovereign or governmental immunity from
- 14 suit is waived and abolished to the extent of liability created by
- 15 this chapter.
- 16 (c) To the extent a person has official or individual
- 17 immunity from a claim for damages, this section does not affect that
- 18 <u>immunity</u>.
