- 4 SECTION 1. Section 25.094(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) An offense under this section may be prosecuted in:
- 7 (1) the constitutional county court of the county in
- 8 which the individual resides or in which the school is located, if
- 9 the county has a population of 1.75 million or more;
- 10 (2) a justice court <u>designated to hear cases arising</u>
- 11 <u>under this section</u> [of any precinct] in the county in which the
- 12 individual resides or in which the school is located, or if no
- 13 justice court is designated, a justice court of any precinct in the
- 14 county in which the individual resides or in which the school is
- 15 located; or
- 16 (3) a municipal court in the municipality in which the
- 17 individual resides or in which the school is located.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 19 25.094, Education Code, apply only to an offense committed on or
- 20 after the effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section,
- 21 an offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any
- 22 element of the offense occurs before that date. An offense
- 23 committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the
- 24 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and

- 1 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
