1-18 relating to pay, benefits and requirements for state active duty

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 437.212, Texas Government Code, is
 1-22 amended by adding Section 437.212 (j) and (k) to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 437.212. PAY, ~~AND~~ BENEFITS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR
 1-24 STATE ACTIVE DUTY, STATE TRAINING, AND OTHER DUTY.

1-25 (j) Claims of discrimination by service members on
 1-26 state active duty shall be processed in accordance with military
 1-27 regulations and procedures established for the Texas military
 1-28 forces; and are exempt from the jurisdiction of the Texas Workforce
 1-29 civil rights division.

1-30 (k) A member of Texas Military Forces called to state
 1-31 active duty is subject to the regulations established for continued
 1-32 membership in the specific component including but not limited to
 1-33 medical readiness, drug testing, physical fitness and training
 1-34 requirements.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on September 1, 2015.
