4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 16(f), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
6	Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
7	(f) In lieu of requiring a defendant to work a specified
8	number of hours at a community service project or projects under
9	Subsection (a), the judge may order a defendant to make a specified
10	donation to a nonprofit food bank or food pantry in the community in
11	which the defendant resides or a charitable organization engaged
12	primarily in performing charitable functions for veterans in the
13	community in which the defendant resides. In this subsection,
14	"charitable organization" has the meaning assigned by Section
15	2252.906, Government Code, and "veteran" has the meaning assigned
16	by Section 434.022, Government Code.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
