3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 31, Election Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 31.013 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 31.013. VOTER EDUCATION PROGRAM FOR HIGH SCHOOL
7	SENIORS. (a) The secretary of state, in consultation with the
8	commissioner of education, shall develop a nonpartisan voter
9	education program designed to be presented to high school seniors.
10	(b) The voter education program developed under Subsection
11	(a) must:
12	(1) provide information concerning:
13	(A) the importance of voting;
14	(B) the manner in which a person may register to
15	<pre>vote in this state;</pre>
16	(C) the manner in which a person may vote using
17	the voting systems most commonly used in this state;
18	(D) election dates, as provided under Chapter 41;
19	(E) the hours polls are open;
20	(F) voting before the date of an election; and
21	(G) how to learn the correct voting location; and
22	(2) provide an opportunity, during the period in which
23	the program is being presented, for students to complete voter
24	registration application forms.

(c) Once each year, at the request of an administrator of a public or private high school, the county clerk for the county in which the school is located, or the clerk's designee, may present the program to high school seniors at the school. The program must

be presented at school during regular school hours.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
