Section 7.056(e), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 7 (e) Except as provided by Subsection (f), a school campus or district may not receive an exemption or waiver under this section 8 9 from: (1) a prohibition on conduct that constitutes a 10 11 criminal offense; 12 (2) a requirement imposed by federal law or rule, 13 including a requirement for special education or bilingual 14 education programs; or 15 (3) a requirement, restriction, or prohibition 16 relating to: essential knowledge or skills under Section 17 (A) 28.002 or high school graduation requirements under Section 28.025; 18 (B) public school accountability as provided by 19 Subchapters B, C, D, E, and J, Chapter 39; 20 21 (C) extracurricular activities under Section 22 33.081 or participation in a University Interscholastic League 23 area, regional, or state competition under Section 33.0812; 24 (D) health and safety under Chapter 38;

1 (E) purchasing under Subchapter B, Chapter 44; 2 elementary school class size limits, except (F) 3 as provided by Section 25.112; 4 (G) removal of a disruptive student from the 5 classroom under Subchapter A, Chapter 37; 6 at-risk programs under Subchapter C, Chapter (H) 7 29; 8 (I) prekindergarten programs under Subchapter E, Chapter 29; 9 educator 10 (J) rights and benefits under Subchapters A, C, D, E, F, G, and I, Chapter 21, or under Subchapter 11 12 A, Chapter 22; special education programs under Subchapter 13 (K) 14 A, Chapter 29; 15 (L) bilingual education programs under Subchapter B, Chapter 29; or 16 17 (M) the requirements for the last [first] day of school [instruction] under Section 25.0812 [25.0811]. 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 25, Education Code, is 19 amended by adding Section 25.0812 to read as follows: 20 21 Sec. 25.0812. LAST DAY OF SCHOOL. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a school district may not schedule the last day of 22 school for students for a school year after the Friday preceding 23 24 Memorial Day. (b) A school district may schedule the last day of school 25 26 for students for a school year after the Friday preceding Memorial Day if the district operates a year-round system under Section 27

(c) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a school district that does not offer each grade level from kindergarten through grade 12 and whose prospective or former students generally attend school in another state for the grade levels the district does not offer may schedule the last day of school on any date permitted under Subsection (a) or the law of the other state.

8 SECTION 3. Section 25.084(a), Education Code, is amended to 9 read as follows:

(a) A school district may operate its schools year-round on
either a single-track or a multitrack calendar. If a school
district adopts a year-round system, the district may modify:

(1) the number of contract days of employees and the number of days of operation, including any time required for staff development, planning and preparation, and continuing education, otherwise required by law;

17 (2) testing dates, data reporting, and related 18 matters;

19 (3) the date of the <u>last</u> [first] day of <u>school for</u> 20 <u>students for a</u> [instruction of the] school year under Section 21 <u>25.0812</u> [25.0811] for a school that was operating year-round for 22 the <u>2014-2015</u> [2000-2001] school year; and

(4) a student's eligibility to participate in
extracurricular activities when the student's calendar track is not
in session.
