4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 13.033(b), Election Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(b) If a person is to be appointed, the registrar shall
8	prepare a certificate of appointment in duplicate containing:
9	(1) the date of appointment;
10	(2) the statement: "I,, Voter Registrar
11	for County, do hereby appoint as a
12	volunteer deputy registrar for County.";
13	(3) the person's residence address;
14	(4) the person's voter registration number, if any;
15	(5) a statement that the term of the appointment
16	expires December 31 of an even-numbered year; and
17	(6) a statement that the appointment terminates on the
18	person's final conviction for an offense for failure to deliver a
19	registration application and may terminate on the registrar's
20	determination that the person failed to adequately review a
21	registration application, intentionally destroyed or physically
22	altered a registration application, or engaged in any other
23	activity that conflicts with the responsibilities of a volunteer
24	deputy registrar under this chapter.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 13.036(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 (b) The registrar may terminate the appointment of a
- 4 volunteer deputy registrar on a determination by the registrar that
- 5 the volunteer deputy:
- 6 <u>(1)</u> failed to adequately review a registration
- 7 application as required by Section 13.039;
- 8 (2) intentionally destroyed or physically altered a
- 9 registration application; or
- 10 (3) engaged in any other activity that conflicts with
- 11 the responsibilities of a volunteer deputy registrar under this
- 12 <u>chapter</u>.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
