2 (b) The registrar may terminate the appointment of a 3 volunteer deputy registrar on a determination by the registrar that 4 the volunteer deputy:

5 (1) failed to adequately review a registration 6 application as required by Section 13.039; or

7 (2) engaged in any other activity that the registrar
8 considers a violation of the responsibilities of a volunteer deputy
9 registrar under this chapter.
