- relating to the planning and funding of water projects to be 2
- constructed in a region other than the region proposing the 3
- 4 project.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 16.053(e-1), Water Code, is amended to 6
- read as follows: 7
- (e-1) A regional water plan may not include a proposal for 8
- 9 the construction of a water project in another regional water
- planning area unless at least two-thirds of the members of the 10
- regional water planning group for that area have consented to the 11
- inclusion of the proposal in the plan [On request of the Texas Water 12
- Advisory Council, a regional planning group shall provide the 13
- council a copy of that planning group's regional water plan]. 14
- SECTION 2. Section 16.053(h)(4), Water Code, is amended to 15
- read as follows: 16
- (4) After the regional water plan is initially 17
- prepared, the regional water planning group shall submit a copy of 18
- the plan to the board. The board shall submit comments on the 19
- 20 regional water plan as to whether the plan meets the requirements of
- <u>Subsections (e) and (e-1)</u> [Subsection (e) of this section]. 21
- 22 SECTION 3. Section 16.053(j), Water Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- (j) The board may provide financial assistance to political 24

- 1 subdivisions under Subchapters E and F of this chapter, Subchapters
- 2 C, D, E, F, J, O, Q, and R, Chapter 15, and Subchapters D, I, K, and
- 3 L, Chapter 17, for water supply projects only if:
- 4 (1) the board determines that the needs to be
- 5 addressed by the project will be addressed in a manner that is
- 6 consistent with the state water plan;
- 7 (2) beginning January 5, 2002[, the board]:
- 8 (A) the board has approved a regional water plan
- 9 as provided by Subsection (i), and any required updates of the plan,
- 10 for the region of the state that includes the area benefiting from
- 11 the proposed project; [and]
- 12 (B) <u>if the proposed project is to be constructed</u>
- 13 in a regional water planning area other than the area benefiting
- 14 from the proposed project, at least two-thirds of the members of the
- 15 regional water planning group for the area in which the proposed
- 16 project is to be constructed have consented to the inclusion in that
- 17 regional water plan of the proposal to construct the project as
- 18 required by Subsection (e-1); and
- 19 <u>(C) the board</u> determines that the needs to be
- 20 addressed by the project will be addressed in a manner that is
- 21 consistent with that regional water plan; and
- 22 (3) the board finds that the water audit required
- 23 under Section 16.0121 has been completed and filed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
