- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 241, Health and Safety
- 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 241.010 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 241.010. DISPOSITION OF FETAL REMAINS. (a) A hospital
- 7 shall release the remains of an unintended, intrauterine fetal
- 8 death on the request of a parent of the unborn child, in a manner
- 9 appropriate under law and the hospital's policy for disposition of
- 10 a human body.
- 11 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), if the remains of an
- 12 unintended, intrauterine fetal death weigh less than 350 grams, a
- 13 hospital shall release the remains on the request of a parent of the
- 14 unborn child, in a manner that is appropriate under law and
- 15 consistent with hospital policy.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
