If it is shown on the trial of an offense under Subsection (a) that the actor has previously been convicted one or 15 16 more times of an offense punishable under this subsection, the offense is punishable by, as applicable: 17 18 (1) a fine according to the schedules as provided by 19 Subsection (c); or 20 (2) a fine calculated in the manner described by Subsection (d). 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 22 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 23 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is

1 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
3 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
4 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
5 before that date.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
