11	system to allow a person to use a digital image displayed on an
12	electronic device for identification purposes or to prove that the
13	person has a driver's license;
14	(2) evaluating risks to personal information security
15	that a system described by Subdivision (1) might create; and
16	(3) surveying and evaluating digital identification
17	and proof of licensure policies in other states.
18	(b) Not later than September 1, 2016, the department shall
19	submit a detailed report of its findings and recommendations to the
20	legislature.
21	(c) This section expires January 1, 2017.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
