6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2261, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 2261.103 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 2261.103. DISCLOSURE PROVISION REQUIRED. (a)
9	Notwithstanding Section 2261.001, this section applies to each
10	contract or agreement for goods or services entered into by a state
11	agency, including a contract or agreement entered into under
12	Chapter 2054, 2254, 2267, or 2269.
13	(b) Each state agency shall include a provision in each of
14	its contracts or agreements for goods or services that requires a
15	party to the contract or agreement and any subcontractor on request
16	to disclose to the state agency information concerning any formula,
17	material, method, work product, trade secret, process, or research
18	used or considered in the performance of the contract or agreement,
19	regardless of whether that information is confidential under any
20	other law.
21	(c) Information disclosed to a state agency under this
22	section is confidential and not subject to disclosure under Chapter
23	552. The disclosure required under this section does not waive or

affect the confidentiality of the information for purposes of state

- 1 or federal law or waive the right to except to the required
- 2 <u>disclosure of the information in the future.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to a contract or agreement entered into on or after the effective
- 5 date of this Act. A contract or agreement entered into before the
- 6 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the
- 7 time the contract or agreement was entered into, and the former law
- 8 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
