- SECTION 2. Section 42.1541(a), Education Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The State Board of Education shall by rule increase the
- 16 indirect cost allotments established under Sections 42.151(h),
- 17 42.152(c), [42.153(b),] and 42.154(c) [42.154(a-1),] and in
- 18 effect for the 2010-2011 school year in proportion to the average
- 19 percentage reduction in total state and local maintenance and
- 20 operations revenue provided under this chapter for the 2011-2012
- 21 school year as a result of S.B. Nos. 1 and 2, Acts of the 82nd
- 22 Legislature, 1st Called Session, 2011.
- SECTION 3. Section 42.153(c), Education Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
