A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- relating to an intercollegiate athletics fee at Stephen F. Austin 2
- State University; authorizing imposition of a fee. 3
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is 5
- amended by adding Section 54.5202 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 54.5202. INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS FEE; STEPHEN F. 7
- AUSTIN STATE UNIVERSITY. (a) The board of regents of Stephen F. 8
- 9 Austin State University may charge each student enrolled at the
- university an intercollegiate athletics fee in an amount not to 10
- exceed \$10 per semester credit hour for each semester or summer 11
- session. 12

- (b) The board of regents may prorate the amount of the fee 13
- 14 for a summer session.
- 15 (c) A student enrolled in more than 15 semester credit hours
- 16 shall pay the fee in an amount equal to the amount imposed on a
- student enrolled in 15 semester credit hours during the same 17
- semester or session. 18
- (d) Revenue from the fee charged under this section may be 19
- used only for financing, constructing, operating, maintaining, or 20
- improving an athletic facility or for operating an intercollegiate 21
- athletics program at the university. 22
- 23 (e) The fee may not be charged unless approved by a majority
- vote of the students enrolled at the university who participate in a 24

- 1 general student election held for that purpose.
- 2 (f) The amount of the fee per semester credit hour may be
- 3 increased from one academic year to the next only if approved by a
- 4 majority vote of the students participating in a general student
- 5 election held for that purpose or, if the amount of the increase
- 6 does not exceed five percent, by a majority vote of the legislative
- 7 body of the student government of the university.
- 8 (g) The chief fiscal officer of the university shall collect
- 9 the fee and shall deposit the revenue from the fee in an account to
- 10 be known as the intercollegiate athletics fee account.
- 11 (h) A fee charged under this section is not considered in
- 12 determining the maximum amount of student services fees that may be
- 13 charged each student enrolled at the university under Section
- 14 54.503.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
