5	SECTION 1. Chapter 59, Occupations Code, is amended to read
6	as follows:
7	CHAPTER 59. INFORMATION REGARDING LICENSE APPLICANT [RELATING TO
8	<del>LICENSING</del> ]
9	Sec. 59.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "License" means a license, certificate,
11	registration, permit, or other authorization that:
12	(A) is issued by a licensing authority; and
13	(B) a person must obtain to practice or engage in
14	a particular business, occupation, or profession.
15	(2) "Licensing authority" means a department,
16	commission, board, office, or other agency of the state that issues
17	a license. The term includes the Supreme Court of Texas.
18	Sec. 59.002. IMMIGRATION STATUS OF APPLICANT. A licensing
19	authority may not consider the immigration status of an applicant
20	for a license in determining whether to issue or renew the license.
21	Sec. 59.003. TAXPAYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER. A licensing
22	authority that requires an applicant for a license to submit the
23	applicant's social security number shall accept as a substitute for
24	the social security number the applicant's individual taxpayer

- 2 Sec. 59.004. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
- 3 [SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER]. (a) Except as provided by Subsection
- 4 (b), the  $[\frac{The}{}]$  social security number or individual taxpayer
- 5 identification number of an applicant for or holder of a license  $[\tau]$
- 6 certificate of registration, or other legal authorization] issued
- 7 by a licensing <u>authority</u> [agency to practice in a specific
- 8 occupation or profession] that is provided to the licensing
- 9 authority [agency] is confidential and not subject to disclosure
- 10 under Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 11 (b) A licensing authority may share with a regulatory agency
- 12 of another state the individual taxpayer identification number of
- 13 an applicant for or holder of a license if:
- 14 (1) the licensing authority requires an applicant to
- 15 pass a national examination as part of the license eligibility
- 16 <u>requirements; and</u>
- 17 (2) a reciprocity agreement exists with the other
- 18 state.
- 19 SECTION 2. (a) Chapter 59, Occupations Code, as amended by
- 20 this Act, applies only to an application for an original or renewal
- 21 license submitted on or after February 1, 2016. An application
- 22 submitted before February 1, 2016, is governed by the law in effect
- 23 on the date the application was submitted, and the former law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 25 (b) Not later than January 1, 2016, each licensing
- 26 authority, as that term is defined by Section 59.001, Occupations
- 27 Code, as amended by this Act, shall adopt rules and prescribe forms
