Article 45.054(j), Code of Criminal Procedure, 11 12 as amended by this Act, applies to a proceeding for failure to attend school that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act 13 14 regardless of whether the offense that is the subject of the proceeding was committed before, on, or after the effective date of 15 this Act. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 17
