- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.103, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection (c-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) The basic allotment of a school district that contains
- 9 at least 150 square miles but less than 300 square miles and has not
- 10 more than 1,600 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by
- 11 applying the formula:
- 12 $AA = (1 + ((1,600 ADA) \times .00035 [.00025])) \times ABA$
- 13 <u>(c-1)</u> The basic allotment of a school district that contains
- 14 less than 150 square miles and has not more than 1,600 students in
- 15 average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula:
- $AA = (1 + ((1,600 ADA) \times .0003)) \times ABA$
- 17 (d) The basic allotment of a school district that offers a
- 18 kindergarten through grade 12 program and has less than 5,000
- 19 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the
- 20 formula, of the following formulas, that results in the greatest
- 21 adjusted allotment:
- 22 (1) the formula in Subsection (b), $[extit{or}]$ (c), or (c-1)
- 23 for which the district is eligible; or
- 24 (2) $AA = (1 + ((5,000 ADA) \times .000025)) \times ABA.$
