- 9 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION PROGRAMS. (a) As a pilot program to enable
- 10 the state to evaluate the benefit of providing additional funding
- 11 at the prekindergarten level for low-income students, the
- 12 <u>commissioner shall provide prekindergarten funding in accordance</u>
- 13 with this section to a school district located in a county that
- 14 borders the United Mexican States and the Gulf of Mexico.
- 15 (b) The commissioner shall provide funding for a school
- 16 district's prekindergarten program on a half-day basis for a number
- 17 of low-income prekindergarten students equal to twice the number of
- 18 students who received, as a result of participation in an early high
- 19 school graduation program operated by the district, a high school
- 20 diploma from the district during the preceding school year after
- 21 three years of secondary school attendance.
- (c) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to implement
- 23 this section.
- 24 (d) This section expires September 1, 2023.
