## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to requiring governmental entities to participate in the
3	federal electronic verification of employment authorization
4	program or E-verify.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 6, Government Code, is amended
7	by adding Chapter 619 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 619. VERIFICATION OF EMPLOYEE INFORMATION
9	Sec. 619.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "E-verify program" means the electronic
11	verification of employment authorization program of the federal
12	Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996
13	(Pub. L. No. 104-208, reprinted in note, 8 U.S.C. Section 1324a),
14	operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security, or a
15	successor employment authorization program designated by the
16	United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal
17	agency authorized to verify the employment authorization status of
18	newly hired employees under the federal Immigration Reform and
19	Control Act of 1986 (8 U.S.C. Section 1101 et seq.).
20	(2) "Governmental entity" means:
21	(A) the state; or
22	(B) a political subdivision of the state,
23	including a municipality, a county, or any kind of district.
24	Sec. 619.002. VERIFICATION. A governmental entity shall

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- 1 register and participate in the E-verify program to verify
- 2 information of all new employees.
- 3 <u>Sec. 619.003.</u> RULES. The Texas Workforce Commission shall
- 4 adopt rules and prescribe forms to implement this chapter.
- 5 Sec. 619.004. TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT. An employee of a
- 6 governmental entity who is responsible for verifying information of
- 7 new employees of the governmental entity as required by Section
- 8 619.002 is subject to immediate termination of employment if the
- 9 employee fails to comply with that section.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
