 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the purchase of certain insurance by public school
 1-22 districts.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 38.024(a), Education Code, is amended to
 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (a) In compliance with this section, the board of trustees
 1-27 of a school district may obtain insurance against bodily injuries
 1-28 sustained by students while training for or engaging in interschool
 1-29 athletic competition or while engaging in school-sponsored
 1-30 activities [~~on a school campus~~].

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
 1-32 school year.

1-33 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
