4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 202, Property Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 202.019 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 202.019. REGULATION OF LIQUID PROPANE GAS TANKS. (a)
8	A property owners' association may not, except as provided by this
9	section, adopt or enforce a dedicatory instrument provision that
10	prohibits, restricts, or has the effect of prohibiting or
11	restricting a property owner from installing a liquid propane gas
12	tank above ground on the owner's residential property if the tank is
13	a size reasonably necessary to meet the gas requirements of the
14	residence.
15	(b) The property owners' association may require the owner
16	to screen the tank from view with reasonable screening materials.
17	(c) A property owners' association may adopt or enforce a
18	dedicatory instrument provision that prohibits or restricts the
19	installation of a liquid propane gas tank that:
20	(1) as adjudicated by a court:
21	(A) threatens the public health or safety; or
22	(B) violates a law;
23	(2) is located on property other than property owned
24	and maintained by the property owner;

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1	(3) is located in an area on the property owner's
2	property other than a rear or side yard and is not:
3	(A) surrounded by a solid privacy fence approved
4	by the association; or
5	(B) otherwise screened in a manner approved by

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
