A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to medical assistance reimbursement for certain health
- 3 care services provided by a chiropractor.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.024, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (kk) to read as follows:
- 7 (kk) The department shall provide medical assistance
- 8 reimbursement to a chiropractor participating in the medical
- 9 assistance program for the provision of a health care service to a
- 10 recipient of medical assistance if:
- 11 <u>(1) the chiropractor is licensed to practice</u>
- 12 chiropractic in this state;
- 13 (2) the chiropractor is authorized to provide the
- 14 service as part of the practice of chiropractic; and
- 15 (3) the service is otherwise covered under the medical
- 16 assistance program.

- 17 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 18 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 19 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 20 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 21 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 22 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
