1-21 relating to funding for the Texas Academy of Leadership in the
 1-22 Humanities.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 96.707(k), Education Code, is amended to
 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (k) For each student enrolled in the academy, the academy is
 1-27 entitled to allotments from the Foundation School Program under
 1-28 Chapter 42 as if the academy were a school district without a tier
 1-29 one local share for purposes of Section 42.253 [~~except that the~~
 1-30 ~~academy has a local share applied that is equivalent to the local~~
 1-31 ~~fund assignment of the Beaumont Independent School District].~~

1-32 SECTION 2. Section 96.707(k), Education Code, as amended by
 1-33 this Act, applies beginning with the 2015-2016 academic year.

1-34 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
