## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the punishment for the offense of indecent exposure.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 21.08, Penal Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (b) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor,
- 8 except that the offense is:
- 9 (1) a Class A misdemeanor if it is shown on the trial
- 10 of the offense that the defendant has been previously convicted one
- 11 time of an offense under this section; and
- 12 (2) a state jail felony if it is shown on the trial of
- 13 the offense that the defendant has been previously convicted two or
- 14 more times of an offense under this section.
- 15 (c) For purposes of Subsection (b), a defendant has been
- 16 previously convicted under this section if the defendant was
- 17 adjudged guilty of the offense or entered a plea of guilty or nolo
- 18 contendere in return for a grant of deferred adjudication,
- 19 regardless of whether the sentence for the offense was ever imposed
- 20 or whether the sentence was probated and the defendant was
- 21 <u>subsequently discharged from community supervision.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 24 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is

- 1 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 2 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes
- 3 of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date
- 4 of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
