7	(b) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor <u>,</u>

9	(1) a Class A misdemeanor if it is shown on the trial
10	of the offense that the defendant has been previously convicted one

12	(2) a state jail felony if it is shown on the trial of
13	the offense that the defendant has been previously convicted two or

15	(c) For purposes of Subsection (b), a defendant has been
16	previously convicted under this section if the defendant was
17	adjudged guilty of the offense or entered a plea of guilty or nolo
18	contendere in return for a grant of deferred adjudication,
19	regardless of whether the sentence for the offense was ever imposed
20	or whether the sentence was probated and the defendant was
21	subsequently discharged from community supervision.
22	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
23	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

1 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 2 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes 3 of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date 4 of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
