A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

H.B. No. 782

1 AN ACT

2 relating to authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds to fund an

- 3 academic building at the University of Houston.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 55.17831 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 55.17831. UNIVERSITY OF HOUSTON SYSTEM; ADDITIONAL
- 8 BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this
- 9 subchapter, the board of regents of the University of Houston
- 10 System may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate,
- 11 enlarge, or equip property and facilities, including roads and
- 12 related infrastructure, for an academic building located in Sugar
- 13 Land, Texas, to be financed through the issuance of bonds in
- 14 accordance with this subchapter, including bonds issued in
- 15 accordance with a systemwide revenue financing program and secured
- 16 as provided by that program, in an aggregate principal amount not to
- 17 <u>exceed \$91,350,000</u>.
- 18 (b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of bonds
- 19 <u>authorized by this section all or any part of the revenue funds of</u>
- 20 <u>an institution</u>, branch, or entity of the University of Houston
- 21 System, including student tuition charges. The amount of a pledge
- 22 made under this subsection may not be reduced or abrogated while the
- 23 bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds issued to refund those
- 24 bonds, are outstanding.

- 1 <u>(c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board to</u> 2 <u>meet its obligations under this section, the board may transfer</u>
- 3 funds among institutions, branches, and entities of the University
- 4 of Houston System to ensure the most equitable and efficient
- 5 allocation of available resources for each institution, branch, or
- 6 entity to carry out its duties and purposes.
- 7 (d) Any portion of the proceeds of bonds authorized by this
- 8 section that is not required for the specific project for which the
- 9 bonds are authorized may be used to renovate existing structures
- 10 and facilities at the University of Houston.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
