11	(c) <u>Satisfactory proof of eligibility for a license plate</u>
12	issued under this section to a retired member of the United States
13	armed forces may be demonstrated by:
14	(1) a [A] letter from any branch of the military under
15	the jurisdiction of the United States Department of Defense or the
16	United States Department of Homeland Security stating that a
17	retired member has 20 or more years of satisfactory federal
18	service <u>; or</u>
19	(2) an identification card issued by any branch of the
20	military under the jurisdiction of the United States Department of
21	Defense or the United States Department of Homeland Security
22	indicating that the member is retired [is satisfactory proof of
23	eligibility].

9 (3) members of a reserve component of the United 10 States armed forces.

11 (c) <u>Satisfactory proof of eligibility for a license plate</u> 12 <u>issued under this section to a retired member of the Texas National</u> 13 <u>Guard or Texas State Guard may be demonstrated by:</u>

14 <u>(1) a</u> [A] letter from the United States Department of 15 Defense, the Department of the Army, or the Department of the Air 16 Force stating that a retired guard member has 20 or more years of 17 satisfactory federal service; or

18 (2) an identification card issued by the United States
19 Department of Defense, the Department of the Army, or the
20 Department of the Air Force indicating that the member is retired
21 [is satisfactory proof of eligibility].
