A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a task force to study methods to prevent the theft of 3 desert plants. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Agriculture Code, is amended by 5 adding Section 12.052 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 12.052. STUDY OF METHODS TO PREVENT DESERT PLANT THEFT. (a) Not later than December 1, 2015, the commissioner shall 8 9 appoint a task force to study methods to prevent the theft of desert plants from private property, including the following genera of 10 plants: 11 12 (1) Agave; (2) Ariocarpus; 13 (3) Echinocactus; (4) Echinocereus;

- 19 (8) Yucca.
- 20 <u>(b) The task force shall study the sale and transportation</u>
 21 <u>of desert plants and methods to prevent the theft of desert plants</u>
- 22 from private property. The task force may study the feasibility and
- 23 effectiveness of:
- 24 (1) implementing registration requirements for

- 1 persons who sell or transport desert plants;
- 2 (2) requiring persons who sell or transport desert
- 3 plants to enter into a compliance agreement with a state agency;
- 4 (3) requiring persons who sell or transport desert
- 5 plants to document the origin of the plants;
- 6 (4) authorizing a state agency to issue stop-sale
- 7 orders regarding or to seize desert plants that do not comply with
- 8 legal requirements;
- 9 (5) imposing civil, criminal, or administrative
- 10 penalties for persons who steal desert plants and for persons who
- 11 fail to comply with legal requirements governing the sale or
- 12 transportation of desert plants; and
- 13 (6) taking any other action to regulate the sale or
- 14 transportation of desert plants and prevent the theft of desert
- 15 plants, as determined by the task force.
- 16 (c) Not later than December 1, 2016, the task force shall
- 17 submit to the house committees on agriculture and livestock and
- 18 appropriations a report that includes recommendations for
- 19 legislation to regulate the sale or transportation of desert plants
- 20 and prevent the theft of desert plants from private property.
- 21 (d) This section expires December 31, 2016.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
