## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to employment of persons with professional qualifications
3 as public school teachers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 21.003, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-2) to read as 7 follows:

Except as provided by Subsection (a-2), a [A] person may 8 (a) 9 not be employed as a teacher, teacher intern or teacher trainee, aide, 10 librarian, educational administrator, educational diagnostician, or school counselor by a school district unless the 11 person holds an appropriate certificate or permit issued as 12 13 provided by Subchapter B.

14 (a-2) Subject to the approval of the board of trustees, a person with professional qualifications may be employed as a 15 16 teacher by a school district to teach introductory courses related to the person's profession regardless of whether the person holds 17 an appropriate certificate or permit issued as provided by 18 Subchapter B. For purposes of this subsection, "person with 19 professional qualifications" means a person who engages in a 20 profession that requires the person to hold a license issued by the 21 22 appropriate state agency.

23 SECTION 2. Section 21.057(d), Education Code, is amended to 24 read as follows:

No. 810 1 (d) For purposes of this section, "inappropriately certified or uncertified teacher": 2 (1)includes: 3 4 (A) an individual serving on an emergency 5 certificate issued under Section 21.041(b)(2); or 6 (B) an individual who does hold not any 7 certificate or permit issued under this chapter and is not employed 8 as specified by Subdivision (2)(E) or (G); and (2) does not include an individual: 9 (A) who is a certified teacher assigned to teach 10 a class or classes outside his or her area of certification, as 11 12 determined by rules proposed by the board in specifying the certificate required for each assignment; 13 14 (B) serving on a certificate issued due to a 15 hearing impairment under Section 21.048; 16 (C) serving on a certificate issued pursuant to 17 enrollment in an approved alternative certification program under Section 21.049; 18 certified by another state or country and 19 (D) serving on a certificate issued under Section 21.052; 20 21 serving on a school district teaching permit (E) issued under Section 21.055; [or] 22 23 (F) employed under a waiver granted by the 24 commissioner pursuant to Section 7.056; or 25 (G) employed in accordance with Section 26 21.003(a-2). SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
