- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 141, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 141.005 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 141.005. UNLAWFUL MISREPRESENTATION OF RESIDENCY
- 8 STATUS. (a) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or
- 9 <u>intentionally misrepresents the person's residency to appear</u>
- 10 eligible to be a candidate for, or elected or appointed to, a public
- 11 elective office in this state.
- 12 (b) An offense under this section is a felony of the third
- 13 <u>degree</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
