A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to housing services provided through the transitional
3	living services program to certain children in the conservatorship
4	of the Department of Family and Protective Services.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 264.121, Family Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
8	(i) The department shall ensure that each youth's
9	transition plan includes a housing stability plan that:
10	(1) identifies the cost of housing in relation to the
11	youth's sources of income, including any benefits or rental
12	assistance available to the youth;
13	(2) identifies any housing agreement that the youth
14	has entered into with family or friends and ensures that in making
15	the agreement the youth has considered:
16	(A) the length of time the youth expects to stay
17	in the housing arrangement;
18	(B) expectations for the youth regarding paying
19	rent and meeting other household obligations;
20	(C) the youth's psychological and emotional
21	needs, as applicable; and
22	(D) any potential conflicts with other household
23	members, or any difficulties connected to the type of housing the
24	youth is seeking, that may arise based on the youth's psychological

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- 1 <u>and emotional needs;</u>
- 2 (3) informs the youth about emergency shelters and
- 3 <u>housing resources;</u>
- 4 (4) ensures that the youth understands a common rental
- 5 application and possesses all of the documentation required to
- 6 successfully obtain rental housing; and
- 7 (5) identifies any individuals who are able to serve
- 8 <u>as cosigners or references on the youth's applications for housing.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
