- 2 relating to the hours of instruction required to be eligible for a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1602.254(b), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) To be eligible for an operator license, an applicant
- 8 must meet the requirements of Subsection (c) or:
- 9 (1) be at least 17 years of age;
- 10 (2) have obtained a high school diploma or the
- 11 equivalent of a high school diploma or have passed a valid
- 12 examination administered by a certified testing agency that
- 13 measures the person's ability to benefit from training; and
- 14 (3) have completed:
- 15 (A) 1,165 [ $\frac{1,500}{}$ ] hours of instruction in a
- 16 licensed beauty culture school; or
- 17 (B)  $765 \left[\frac{1,000}{1}\right]$  hours of instruction in beauty
- 18 culture courses and  $\underline{400}$  [500] hours of related high school courses
- 19 prescribed by the commission in a vocational cosmetology program in
- 20 a public school.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 22 1602.254(b), Occupations Code, applies only to application for a
- 23 license submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 24 application for a license submitted before that date is governed by

- $1 \hspace{0.1in}$  the law in effect on the date the application was submitted, and the
- 2 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
