- 12 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections
- 13 1601.257 and 1601.262, Occupations Code, apply only to an

- 15 technician/manicurist specialty license submitted on or after the
- 16 effective date of this Act. An application for a manicurist license
- 17 or barber technician/manicurist specialty license submitted before
- 18 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 19 the date the application was submitted, and the former law is
- 20 continued in effect for that purpose.
