- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- by adding Section 151.358 to read as follows: 6
- 7 Sec. 151.358. FIREARMS AND HUNTING SUPPLIES FOR LIMITED
- PERIOD. (a) In this section, "hunting supplies" means ammunition, 8
- archery equipment, hunting blinds and stands, hunting decoys, 9
- firearm cleaning supplies, gun cases and gun safes, hunting optics, 10
- 11 and hunting safety equipment.
- 12 (b) The sale of a firearm or hunting supplies is exempted
- from the taxes imposed by this chapter if the sale takes place 13
- 14 during a period:
- (1) beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the Saturday of the last 15
- 16 full weekend in August and ending at 12 midnight on the following
- 17 Sunday; or

- 18 (2) beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the Saturday of the last
- full weekend in October and ending at 12 midnight on the following 19
- 20 Sunday.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 22 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been 23
- enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the 24

- 1 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 2 the liability for those taxes.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
