Effective September 1, 2020, Section 73.101(a), Property Code, is amended to read as follows: 13 14 (a) An account or safe deposit box is presumed abandoned if: [except as provided by Subsection (c),] 15 (1)the account or safe deposit box has been inactive for at least five 16 years as determined under Subsection (b); 17 (2) the location of the depositor of the account or 18 owner of the safe deposit box is unknown to the depository; and 19 (3) the amount of the account or the contents of the 20 21 box have not been delivered to the comptroller in accordance with 22 Chapter 74.
