- 2 relating to the rules of the road regarding red signals at certain

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 544.007, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (d) An operator of a vehicle facing only a steady red signal
- 9 shall stop at a clearly marked stop line. In the absence of a stop
- 10 line, the operator shall stop before entering the crosswalk on the
- 11 near side of the intersection. Except as provided by Subsection
- 12 (d-1), a [A] vehicle that is not turning shall remain standing until
- 13 an indication to proceed is shown. After stopping, standing until
- 14 the intersection may be entered safely, and yielding right-of-way
- 15 to pedestrians lawfully in an adjacent crosswalk and other traffic
- 16 lawfully using the intersection, the operator may:
- 17 (1) turn right; or
- 18 (2) turn left, if the intersecting streets are both
- 19 one-way streets and a left turn is permissible.
- 20 (d-1) An operator of a vehicle facing only a steady red
- 21 signal at a traffic-actuated electric traffic-control signal, as
- 22 described by Section 544.0075, may proceed if the traffic-actuated
- 23 electric traffic-control signal fails to register the vehicle
- 24 within a reasonable period of time. The right to proceed is subject

- 1 to the rules applicable after stopping at a stop sign.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
