## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1701.316, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) The commission shall reactivate a peace officer's
8	license after a break in employment if the former license holder:
9	(1) completed at least 10 years of full-time service
10	as a peace officer in good standing before the break in employment;
11	(2) meets current licensing standards;
12	(3) successfully completes:
13	(A) an online or in-person supplemental peace
14	officer course of not more than 120 hours; and
15	(B) other in-person training requirements of not
16	more than 40 hours;
17	(4) passes a peace officer reactivation examination;
18	(5) files an application; and
19	(6) pays any required fees.
20	SECTION 2. Section 1701.316(c), Occupations Code, as added
21	by this Act, applies only to a license for which an application for
22	reactivation of the license is filed on or after the effective date
23	of this Act. A license for which an application for reactivation of
2/1	the license is filed before the effective date of this Act is

- 1 governed by the law in effect on the date the application was filed,
- 2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
