## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the director and assistant director of the Texas
- 3 Military Preparedness Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 436.057, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (a-1), (b), and (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) The commission shall, subject to approval of the
- 8 governor, hire an assistant director to assist the director in the
- 9 performance of the administrative duties of the commission.
- 10 (b) The commission, in hiring the director and the assistant
- 11 director, shall consider applicants who have significant and
- 12 <u>extensive experience</u> and knowledge relating to military
- 13 installation operations, the defense industry, and the United
- 14 States Department of Defense, including retired senior military
- 15 officers from any branch of the armed forces of the United States.
- 16 (d) The director may not hold another position in the office
- of the governor.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
