A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the director and assistant director of the Texas  
3 Military Preparedness Commission.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 436.057, Government Code, is amended by  
6 adding Subsections (a-1), (b), and (d) to read as follows:

7 (a-1) The commission shall, subject to approval of the  
8 governor, hire an assistant director to assist the director in the  
9 performance of the administrative duties of the commission.

10 (b) The commission, in hiring the director and the assistant  
11 director, shall consider applicants who have significant and  
12 extensive experience and knowledge relating to military  
13 installation operations, the defense industry, and the United  
14 States Department of Defense, including retired senior military  
15 officers from any branch of the armed forces of the United States.

16 (d) The director may not hold another position in the office  
17 of the governor.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
