- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 436.057, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (a-1), (b), and (d) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(a-1)</u> The commission shall hire an assistant director to
- 8 <u>assist the director in the performance of the administrative duties</u>
- 9 of the commission.
- 10 (b) Either the director or the assistant director must be
- 11 recently retired from the armed forces with a rank of colonel or
- 12 above in the army, marines, or air force or captain or above in the
- 13 navy or coast guard.
- 14 (d) The director may not hold another position in the office
- 15 of the governor.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
