1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to certain county bail bond boards.  
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 1704.055(c), Occupations Code, is  
 1-22 amended to read as follows:  
 1-23 (c) A board in a county with a population of less than  
 1-24 150,000 [~~50,000~~] shall meet:  
 1-25 (1) at least four times each year during the months of  
 1-26 January, April, July, and October at the call of the presiding  
 1-27 officer; and  
 1-28 (2) at other times at the call of the presiding  
 1-29 officer.  
 1-30 SECTION 2. Section 1704.162, Occupations Code, is amended  
 1-31 by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:  
 1-32 (h) Notwithstanding the expiration date of a license issued  
 1-33 under this chapter, if a board to which Section 1704.055(c) applies  
 1-34 tables a license holder's application for renewal or otherwise does  
 1-35 not take action to approve or deny the application, the applicant's  
 1-36 current license continues in effect until the next meeting of the  
 1-37 board.  
 1-38 SECTION 3. Section 1704.162(h), Occupations Code, as added  
 1-39 by this Act, applies only to an application for renewal of a license  
 1-40 filed with a county bail bond board on or after the effective date  
 1-41 of this Act. An application filed before that date is governed by  
 1-42 the law in effect at the time the application was filed, and the  
 1-43 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.  
 1-44 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
