1 system to defraud or harm another or alter, damage, or delete
2 property.

3 (f) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (b-1)(2)
4 that the actor's conduct consisted solely of action taken pursuant
5 to a contract that was entered into with the owner of the computer,
6 computer network, or computer system for the purpose of assessing
7 the security of the computer, network, or system or providing other
8 security-related services.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 9 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 10 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 11 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 12 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 13 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 14 15 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 16 before that date.
