SECTION 2. The amendment made by this Act to Section 1 5A(a)(5), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, 2 Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil 3 Statutes), is intended only to clarify existing law on the 4 eligibility of certain events to receive funding from the Major 5 6 Events trust fund. Each event held on or after the effective date of that Act and the event's eligibility to receive funding from the 7 8 Major Events trust fund are governed by the law as clarified by this Act. 9

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
