## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of a long-range revenue analysis
3	committee.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 403.0306 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 403.0306. LONG-RANGE REVENUE ANALYSIS COMMITTEE. (a)
8	The long-range revenue analysis committee shall produce biannual
9	long-range financial projection and revenue reports to assist the
10	legislature in making budget decisions.
11	(b) The committee is composed of:
12	(1) one representative appointed by the chair of the
13	house appropriations committee;
14	(2) one representative appointed by the chair of the
15	senate finance committee;
16	(3) one representative appointed by the Legislative
17	Budget Board;
18	(4) one representative appointed by the governor; and
19	(5) one representative appointed by the comptroller.
20	(c) A representative appointed under Subsection (b) serves
21	at the pleasure of the appointing authority. The appropriate
22	appointing authority shall fill a vacancy in the committee by the
23	appointment of another person.
24	(d) The member of the committee appointed under Subsection

- 1 (b)(3) shall serve as the chair of the committee.
- 2 (e) The committee shall meet at least quarterly. The
- 3 committee may meet at other times at the call of the chair of the
- 4 committee.
- 5 (f) The committee is not subject to Chapter 2110.
- 6 (g) The committee may request assistance with gathering
- 7 data, performing analysis, developing financial forecasts and
- 8 official estimates, or any other relevant tasks from any
- 9 department, agency, institution, office, or political subdivision
- 10 of this state.
- 11 (h) Between September 1 and September 15 of each
- 12 even-numbered year, the committee shall issue a long-range revenue
- 13 analysis report that includes:
- 14 (1) revenue estimates and major state financial
- 15 projections for:
- 16 (A) the state fiscal year beginning on the 10th
- 17 anniversary of the date the current state fiscal year began; and
- 18 (B) the state fiscal year beginning on the 20th
- 19 anniversary of the date the current state fiscal year began; and
- 20 (2) recommended fiscal strategies for the state and
- 21 state agencies.
- (i) In creating the report required by Subsection (h), the
- 23 committee shall use current official budget estimates and shall
- 24 seek input from the public, the executive branch, and the judicial
- 25 branch of the state. The committee must reach a consensus on any
- 26 revenue analysis and projections created for each report before the
- 27 analysis or projections may be included in the report.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2015, each appointing
- 2 authority specified by Section 403.0306(b), Government Code, as
- 3 added by this Act, shall make the authority's initial appointment
- 4 to the long-range revenue analysis committee.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
