6 SECTION 7. Not later than December 1, 2015, the Texas 7 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules to 8 implement the changes in law made by this Act to Chapters 1901 and 9 1902, Occupations Code.

10 SECTION 8. The Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation 11 may not require a person to hold a license or license specialty 12 endorsement as an apprentice driller or apprentice pump installer 13 under Sections 1901.153 and 1902.153, Occupations Code, as added by 14 this Act, before June 1, 2016.

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SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
