## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the disqualification from receiving unemployment
- 3 benefits of certain individuals who are terminated from employment
- 4 after giving notice of resignation.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 207.045, Labor Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (g-2) to read as follows:
- 8 (g-2) An individual who left the individual's last work,
- 9 other than for circumstances described by Subsection (d), (f), (g),
- 10 (g-1), or (j), after giving advance notice to the individual's
- 11 employer of the individual's resignation and whose employment was
- 12 terminated by the employer before the date stated in the advance
- 13 <u>notice of resignation as the individual's last day of work is</u>
- 14 disqualified for benefits under Subsection (a), regardless of
- 15 whether the employer paid the individual for the entire notice
- 16 period.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a claim for unemployment compensation benefits filed with the
- 19 Texas Workforce Commission on or after the effective date of this
- 20 Act. A claim filed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 21 by the law in effect on the date the claim was filed, and the former
- 22 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
