4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.0021, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
7	(d) If the State Board of Education approves a statistics
8	course as an advanced mathematics course as provided under Section
9	28.025(b-2), as amended by Chapter 211 (H.B. 5), Acts of the 83rd
10	Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, the course must include
11	instruction in personal financial literacy relating to:
12	(1) avoiding and eliminating credit card debt;
13	(2) being a prudent investor in the stock market and
14	using other investment options; and
15	(3) beginning a savings program and planning for
16	retirement.
17	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2016-2017
18	school year.
19	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
