1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to a study of the feasibility of establishing a visitors  
 1-20 center at Hueco Tanks State Park in El Paso County.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. STUDY. The Parks and Wildlife Department shall  
 1-23 conduct a study to examine the need for and feasibility of  
 1-24 establishing a visitors center at Hueco Tanks State Park in El Paso  
 1-25 County. The department shall collaborate with the local community  
 1-26 and surrounding landowners in planning for the development of the  
 1-27 visitors center site.

1-28 SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than May 1, 2016, the Parks  
 1-29 and Wildlife Department shall report the results of the study to the  
 1-30 legislature. The report must contain a recommendation on whether  
 1-31 to establish a visitors center at Hueco Tanks State Park in El Paso  
 1-32 County.

1-33 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. This Act expires January 1, 2017.

1-34 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September  
 1-35 1, 2015.
